

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Bringing Theosophical Women's First Grade College, Hospet under Grant-in-Aid Code - reg.

Read: Letter No.DCE 63 Gulbarga PCC 89 dated 28.6.1990 from the Director of Collegiate Education, Bangalore.

Preamble:

In his letter dated 28.6.1990 read above, the Director of Collegiate Education has sent a proposal for bringing Theosophical Women's First Grade College, Hospet under Grant-in-Aid as that college has completed the five years of non-grant period and is eligible for admission for grants. The proposal has been examined and the following orders are passed.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO.ED 5 UPC 1991  
BANGALORE, DATED 22ND APRIL 1991.

Sanction is accorded to bring Theosophical Women's First Grade College, Hospet under Grant-in-Aid with effect from the date of issue of this order subject to the general conditions laid down in the Grant-in-Aid Code of Collegiate Education Department and also the conditions mentioned below:-

- 1) Taking into account the work-load and staffing pattern etc. 11 (eleven) teaching and 13 (thirteen) non-teaching staff as appended to this order are allowed to be admitted for grants. The Director of Collegiate Education shall verify once again the qualification of the staff.
- 2) No arrears of grants will be paid.
- 3) Prior approval of Competent Authority be obtained while filling vacant posts in future.
- 4) Reservation Policy of Government in matters relating to recruitment, promotion laid down in G.O.No.ED 146 UPC 79 dated 3.10.1981 and also such other orders issued by the Department from time to time be scrupulously followed.
- 5) The student strength, should not be less than the prescribed minimum 80.


Failing to fulfil the said conditions shall entail withdrawal of grants to the College. The Director of Collegiate Education will watch the conditions stipulated and send a report of compliance to Government.

The expenditure on this account shall be met by way of reappropriation out of overall savings of Plan Budget of Education Department during 1991-92 and is debitable to Head of Account "2202. General Education-03-104-Assistance to Non-Govt. Colleges-1-Collegiate Education-02-Bringing Private Colleges under Grant-in-Aid Code (Plan 1991-92)".

The Director of Collegiate Education shall make necessary arrangements to obtain reappropriation orders.

This issues with the concurrence of Planning and Finance Departments vide their U.O.Notes No.PD 67 POP 91 dated 15.4.1991 and No.FD 2182/Exp-8/90 dated 16.2.1991 respectively.


