It has branch in Hosapete and actively involved in social, educational and cultural activities. Our college was established in 1984-85 by Ex-MLA Late Shri. G. Shankar Goud. From that time our college is providing education to women of all communities.

From 2004 our college was affiliated to Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women’s University Vijayapur. NAAC team visited our college in 2005 and 2012 and evaluated all departments and cells and our college was awarded ‘B’ grade in both cycles.

At present 164 students in Arts and 266 students in Commerce total 430 students are studying in our college. At present 14 subjects are taught. Total 15 teaching staff are working, in which 12 are guest lecturers and 6 non-teaching staff are presently working. Out of total teaching staff 3 are Doctorate.
