Since 2004, our college has been affiliated to Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women's University, Vijayapura. In 2005 and 2012 NAAC team visited the college for assessment and checked all the departments and cells and awarded 'B Grade'.

In the current academic year 139 Students have been admitted in the B.A. program and 380 students have been admitted in the B.Com. program. The total number of students is 519.
